

Long Term Plan - MFL - 2025-2026

Pupils will:

- Deepen their understanding of the world by learning about the language and culture of another country.
- Listen to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding.
- Explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words.
- Engage in conversations: ask and answer questions, express ideas, feelings and opinions.
- Speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures.
- Develop accurate pronunciation and intonation so that others can understand when they are speaking or reading aloud.
- Present ideas and information orally to a range of audiences via, songs, poems, stories for example.
- Read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing.
- Describe people, places, things and actions orally and in writing.
- Understand the basic grammar, including feminine, masculine forms and the conjugation of high frequency verbs, key features and patterns of the language, how to apply these to build sentences.
